

# THANK YOU FOR ENTERING DRESSAGE AT DEVONWOOD

**RIDING TIMES:** THE TIMES SENT IN THIS MAILING ARE TENTATIVE, SUBJECT TO CHANGE. ***Every evening, an updated schedule for the next day will be posted at the Horse Show Office.*** We will make every effort to contact those whose times have been adjusted. Do not rely on the times in the show program because they are not the most current version.

There are many reasons that times can change - shortening or lengthening a break, for example, or shortening the day. Sometimes it is to accommodate a rider with a difficult schedule.

**If you have already requested a change or have scratched, the times that were scratched may appear on the Ride Times report and will continue to do so until they have been filled. Please be aware that the absence of a time does not mean that the time is filled and that you are eligible for a refund. In several cases, the times of scratched horses were removed when classes were split, as they would have confused the schedule. The spaces are still there, however.**

**CLASS SPLITS** - Many of the classes have been split into Adult/Amateur, JR/YR and Open sections for awards and there are a number of classes that will be split at the show. Some classes were left intact to facilitate the scheduling of the riders with multiple horses.

**IF YOU ARE AN AMATEUR OR JR/YR AND THE INDICATION UNDER STATUS IS "NO" - DO NOT CALL!!!** All this means is that you are not entered in USDF Qualifying. Do not call if some of your classes are already split out and some are not. The Rider Status on the Confirmation will be tracked throughout the scoring process and classes will be split when appropriate.

**REMINDER ON USDF/GreatAmericanInsuranceGroup Qualifying:** This refers to the highest test of the level and only to those who have paid \$10 to participate in the qualifying for the Region VI Championships. If you have registered to qualify for any USDF qualifying class, your rider status will show under the Qual/Div heading. If it says "No" in that column, then your score will not be turned in to USDF as qualifying.

**Delivery of shavings will be 4-6 pm on Wednesday through Saturday and 8-10 am on Friday and Saturday.**

**TAPES/SOUND CHECK** - Music sound checks will be at 5:00pm Thursday and tapes for sound checks must be turned in to the Announcer one hour before the sound check. If you absolutely cannot be there for the scheduled sound check, please take the CD to the Announcer Tower and arrange a time. CD's must always be handed directly to the Announcer. Please be very clear in your instructions or, even better, have an individual in the Announcer's Booth to supervise the cueing.

**POSTING OF SCORES AND TEST RETRIEVAL:** The class is considered final when the printout that has **FINAL** on it is posted in the scoring area. Tests may not be picked up prior to that time. If you are entered in the Great/Am/Ins/USDFqualifying, be sure that there is a Yes and the appropriate Rider Status listed under Qualifying on the **Final** Report. There should also be a Q on the test sheet. If this type of qualifying has been added at the show, it will most likely not appear on the test label, so it is imperative that the information appears under Qualifying on the Final Report.
